The verses from the first part of the chorus are sung to the tune of the ***Carmagnole***; the second part of the chorus to the tune of ***ça-ira!*** The ***Carmagnole*** was the most popular song of the French Revolution. It dates from 1792: the convocation of the Convention and jailing of the king. It has however since been re-appearing in every revolutionary period of the 19th century: 1830, 1848 and 1871, with new verses being added each time. The ***ça-ira*** is originally a very distinct song, but used to be sung as the chorus of the ***Carmagnole***.
