


# The Pinnacle of Civilization

## The Civilized Peak

**Seven Years' War:** 1756-1763. Our war experts (!) describe it as the “First World War”...

**American Revolution:** 1773-1776-1783.

**French Revolution:** 1789-1805.

- 1791 Constitution: the Citizen-King.
- Revolutionary Terror: May 31<sup>st</sup> 1793-July 27<sup>th</sup> 1794.
- 1799 Constitution: Republic of the Prime Consul.
